The Cologne Graduate School in Management, Economics, and Social Sciences (CGS) of the WiSo-Faculty offers a three-year doctoral program to outstanding students holding a Master's degree (or German Diploma or equivalent) in Management, Economics and Social Sciences. In particular, we offer scholarships integrated in the Faculty's Key Profile Areas:

- Design and Behavior
- Behavioral Management Science
- Digital Transformation
- Demography and Social Inequality
- Markets and Government
- Value and Risk

Joining the Key Profile Areas, Ph.D. scholarships holders will be part of highly vibrant and international research networks in our Faculty. The Research Areas cross disciplinary boundaries to address common research topics to conduct rigorous and relevant research.

### About the Program

The course program will start in October 2018. During the first year, students will take part in courses on multidisciplinary methods and theories and subject-specific courses. During the second and third year, students mainly conduct research and work on their thesis. Students are encouraged to spend one term abroad.

### Qualifications

The CGS is looking for excellent students who are close to finishing their Master's degree and who count among the top 10% of graduates in their Faculty. The program is taught in English.

### Scholarships

Students accepted to the program receive a scholarship of EUR 1.200 per month. The scholarship is awarded for a maximum period of three years and is tax-free. Scholarships start with the course program in October 2018.

After the first year at the CGS you will join the second and third year at the EWI. The rest of the program, the qualifications needed, the procedure and the scholarship itself are the same as mentioned below.
